With her skin-friendly and environmentally friendly creations, Cathy embodies a new generation of committed producers, proud to promote the local riches of Louron.

She also offers free soap-making demonstrations from 2.30pm to 3.30pm on Wednesdays and Fridays in summer and on Fridays in winter.

In Jézeau, Amélie Lahorgue raises Pyrenean goats (a rustic, heritage breed) to produce authentic artisanal cheeses—crottins, faisselles, lingots, fromage blanc—which are sold directly and are highly prized in local markets.

Established in 2013, she practises a form of agriculture that makes the most of her animals' milk and contributes to the preservation of mountain know-how.

Her farm, which is part of the traditional agro-pastoralism of the Aure and Louron valleys, embodies a sustainable approach rooted in the landscape.

La Chèvrerie de Gouaux

Originally from northern France, Stéphanie arrived in the mountains in the mid-1990s, in the Eastern Pyrenees, after completing her accounting studies.

Her personal history and the encounters she had led her to change the course of her life. She returned to study agricultural science as an independent candidate 30 years after her scientific baccalaureate and, a year later, bought the goat farm in Gouaux.

Visitors can watch the milking at 6 p.m. and taste the cheese.

She makes fresh cheeses every day, which are matured over several days to offer different degrees of maturity (fresh, creamy or dry), as well as tomme (made mainly in late winter and spring), flavoured cheeses and spreadable cheeses (goat's cheese on toast).

This year, he has tried making tomme with wild garlic, and the result has been very satisfactory! It will be available at the stall during the next lactation period.

After starting beekeeping in 2009, she expanded her activity in 2022 by launching into laying hen farming, always with an ethical and environmentally friendly approach.

Before embarking on this adventure, she was a social worker, but the desire to lead a lifestyle closer to nature led her to change course. Her husband, a mountain guide, wanted to settle in the Pyrenees, which gave her the opportunity to reinvent herself.

Today, she feels fully fulfilled by this activity, which not only allows her to offer quality products to consumers, but also to contribute to the protection of the environment.

As a potter, Camille creates moulded cups, bowls, plates, glasses and bottles, which she sells directly from her workshop. She works with stoneware for its rusticity, but softens her pieces with touches of delicate engobes and glazes.

Her talent and poetic approach have enabled her to collaborate with renowned gastronomic establishments, such as the restaurants Erassens and L'auberge des Aryelets, renowned for their quality. Her creations, both functional and aesthetic, add a unique touch to these exceptional tables.




Passionate about leatherwork, leather goods maker since 2018.

She trained at the Compagnons du devoir in Marseille. She set up her business in 2023 and today creates understated, authentic items, full of colour, using leather from French tanneries for its quality and proximity. She makes small leather goods from vegetable-tanned goatskin, handbags, card holders, purses, glasses cases... and offers to make all kinds of customised items: bags, knife cases, tool cases...

It manufactures belts from vegetable-tanned cowhide leather and only makes custom-made items. It is particularly interested in repairing leather goods (handbags, belts, jackets) to encourage people not to throw them away and to give a second life to items that have already served their purpose.

Workshops on making leather goods are offered on different occasions.

Lætitia has always been drawn to plants and the natural environment as a whole.

Previously a technician at a design office specialising in waterways and sanitation networks, she moved to the Aure Valley eight years ago, where she worked for various employers in a range of fields (bakery sales, municipal officer, etc.).

Since 2022, she has turned her attention to growing plants: two seasons of market gardening and a distance learning BPREA course with internships, which enabled her to make some wonderful professional and personal connections and bring her aromatic plant growing project to fruition.

So, in the spring of 2025, she moved to a plot of land loaned to her in Grézian, where she grows organic aromatic plants and edible or decorative flowers, from seed to harvest.

She sells her produce fresh and also dries it in a plant-friendly solar dryer to offer dried herbs for use in cooking or infusions.

For the moment, she sells her produce at the markets in Arreau and Saint-Lary. She does not yet offer garden tours, but is considering doing so in the coming years.


